**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **two (2) new cases today**. The County's **active case however count moves down to eight (8)** as **four (4) individuals were released from the COVID-19 protocol**. These new cases are under investigation. The County's **COVID-19 total case count is 38** as our **completed tests count jumps up to 721** as the County has received all but **5 tests results from the mobile test collection sites**. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.

Community's WOW numbers from all mobile test collection sites conducted in San Patricio County:

**354 county residents were tested, only 3 tested positive for COVID-19**
