San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **two (2) new cases today**. **The County's active case count moves to eleven (11)**. These new cases are under investigation. **The County's COVID-19 total case count moves up to 41 and our completed tests count is 727**. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.
