**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Today Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **No New Cases** and four (4) additional completed tests. **The County's COVID-19 total case count stays at 26** and our completed tests count moves up to 343. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.

**Although the County's active case count remains at nine (9), our hospitalization count increased today.** The County has yet to receive the results from the Aransas Pass or Portland mobile test collection sites. Once these results are received, they will be released to the community.
