**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **four (4) new cases today** that are under investigation. **The County's active case count moves up to twenty-six (26)** with an individual in the hospital, and our **Recovered total also moves up as three (3) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol.** The County's **confirmed COVID-19 case count is now 66** and our completed tests count is 769. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.
