**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Department reported **thirty-seven (37) new cases today** that are all under investigation and our hospitalizations count stays at two (2). The **County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 440**. The County's active case count moves up to **187** as this count also denotes that **ten (10) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol**. The County's completed tests count is 1890. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.
