**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Department reported **twenty-seven (27) new cases today** that are all under investigation and our hospitalization count is zero. The **County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 768**. The County's active case count moves down to **253** as this count also denotes that **fifty-one (51) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol**. **DSHS is reporting fifteen (15) COVID-19 fatalities for San Patricio County at the time of this release**. The County's completed tests count is 2380. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.
